



**INSTRUCTIVE FOR THE ACCOMPLISHMENT OF REGIONAL CLASSIFICATIONS TO THE  
CADET AND JUNIOR LATIN AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIPS**

The **LATTU Executive Committee** decided that the **Cadet Junior Regional Championships** are qualifying for the **Cadet and Junior Latin American Championship**, fulfilling therefore a recommendation of the ITTF, that will fortify the participation of our countries in the events of their respective Regions and results in a greater support of the national organisms of each country. In such sense, we agree on the following :

1. Each Region (Caribbean – South American – Central American) will have to make its qualifying regional events in the first trimester of each year, informing to the LATTU, the exact dates and sending Bases of Events so that they are published in the WEB page [www.ultm.org](http://www.ultm.org).
2. The Regional Organisms will have from March 30' 2008, thirty (30) working days in order to inform to the LATTU, the countries classified by its region and Invited single players of its Region.
3. Individual quotas of teams and players by regions that they classified to the Cadet – Junior Latin American Championship will be the following ones :

4. The country that wins the host of the Cadet – Junior Latin American Championship, will take the quota from participation from the region to which it belongs.
5. The players for the single event invited of each Region cannot be more than two (2) by each country in each category and gender. These will have the right to always participate in the events of Doubles and Mixed as long as they can conform pairs to another player of his same country.
6. By ITTF decision, in the Board of Directors in Croatia the past month of April 2007, of the year 2010, the Cadet – Junior Latin American Championship will become Pan-American by the incorporation of the United States and Canadá, duplicating itself the quotas that the LATTU had, for the world events like World Cadets Challenge and the World – Junior Championship.
