PARTICIPANTS: All countries affiliated to and up to date with the Annuities of the Caribbean Region Table Tennis Federation can participate.

ELIGIBILITY: *(U-21) - Players born on or after 1st January of 1996*
(45 +) - Players born before 1st January of 1973

WORLD RANKING: Accompanying entry forms must be scans of the passport data page of each player. This is necessary for the ITTF to allocate World Ranking points for this tournament.

EVENTS: Team Events (Men and Women)
Doubles Events (Men, Women and Mixed)
Singles Events Men, Women, U21, Masters 45+

PLAYING SYSTEM :

Team Events

The team event (Mens and Womens) will be played according the Swaythling system (ABC-XYZ).

First Stage

In the first stage, if the total of participating teams is less than six (6), it will be played according to the “Round Robin” system in one group. If there are six (6) or more teams they will be conformed in as many groups as necessary, with a minimum of three (3) and a maximum of four (4) teams per group.

Second Stage:

If there is no round-robin, the first and second placed teams of each group will compete in an “**Elimination Knock-out System**” to define the final positions.

Doubles Events:

All doubles events will be played under the simple Elimination knock-out System.

The matches will be of five (5) games to win three (3) or the Best of Seven games.

Singles Events :

The single events will be played in two stages. Groups will be conformed as necessary, and they will compete according to "Round Robin" system. The matches will be five (5) games to win (3). The first two players of each group qualify for the final stage. From the quarter finals of the Senior Singles divisions, it will be seven (7) games to win four (4), by a simple Elimination Knock-out System. This seven (7) games to win four (4), will also be for the finals of the Under 21 Male and Female events.

RULES:

The Championship will be conducted according the rules established by the ITTF, under the jurisdiction of the Competition Manager appointed by the CRTTF and sanctioned by the LATTU.

AWARDS:

Trophies or medals to each competitor in the first, second and third place in all Teams, Doubles and Singles events.

MEETING:

Will take place on July 17th at 8:00 pm. The Technical Meeting will be conducted by the Competition Manager designated by CRTTF and sanctioned by the LATTU.

EQUIPMENT:

Tables : 8 with 2 Centre Court
Balls : 3* 40+ mm – Plastic – White – RAISE**

VENUE:

Maximum 8 tables; 2 practice tables
Flooring - Blue rubber

HOSPITALITY:

The Cuban Table Tennis Federation will provide accommodation and meals (all inclusive) at a rate of US\$ 60.00 per day and per official person in the Delegation. Extra accompanying persons will pay USD 80.00 per day. The hotels are Club Acuario and , Hotel Kholly.

The host country will charge the equivalent event US60.00 per day to the countries that arrive 48 hours before and leave 48 hours after the date of the competition. Arrival before or after these dates will incur a cost per day of US\$ 80.00

The host country will be responsible for the costs of hosting the President and Technical Director CRTTF.
